

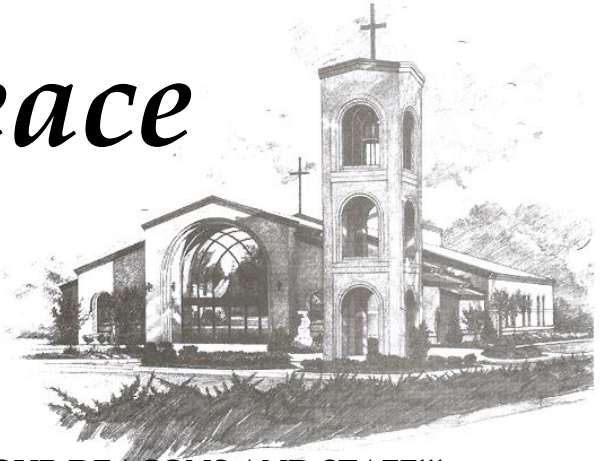

WELCOME BACK ON BEHALF OF FATHER MIKE, OUR DEACONS AND STAFF!!!

We will re-open for Weekend Mass Services this Saturday June 13th. There are many things we will need to be compliant about in order to continue to offer these services. We will also assess the number of attendees and adjust services if necessary on the 21st, so please stay tuned our Website will be updated with the most current information. We may still need to broadcast if the church fills up.

REQUIREMENTS:

- We will need to have the Church professionally sanitized at least once weekly.
- Everyone in attendance will be required to wear a mask and gloves.
- Every family will be required to maintain a social distance of 6 feet from other families.
- Receiving communion will be allowed but after the final blessing to allow for social distancing. This will occur at the Altar with tape markings to identify social distancing requirements.
- Missalettes are **STRICTLY PROHIBITED** so we've decided to give every family a copy of an unused Missalette to keep and bring with them every time they return for Mass.
- We are asking all ushers, Eucharistic Ministers and Lectors who feel comfortable returning to the church to please email the office, at office@olopnb.org. We may host a virtual meeting to go over new responsibilities and COVID 19 regulations.
- Please understand that there will be a limit to our capacity. We learned 6/9/20 that it is **only 50 people per the State of NJ**. We were hoping for at least 100 based on our capacity. We have yet to have to turn anyone away for our parking lot services so we hope the same holds true for this Phase.
- PLEASE NOTE THAT CURRENTLY SPECIAL DISPENSATION IS STILL IN EFFECT. If you feel compromised or if you are not well please stay home Father is still broadcasting Mass daily on the OLOPNBChurch FaceBook page. Live at 8:00am or available throughout the day.
- Many have asked about the Sacrament of Penance, please note the new time; Saturdays from 3:30 to 4:30 pm.
- The ushers will have a basket available for collecting your contributions.
- The ushers will guide you to an approved seat and lead the next family to a seat 6 feet away.
- We are asking for **VOLUNTEERS** to stay after Mass and help wipe the entire church down for 15-20 minutes.
